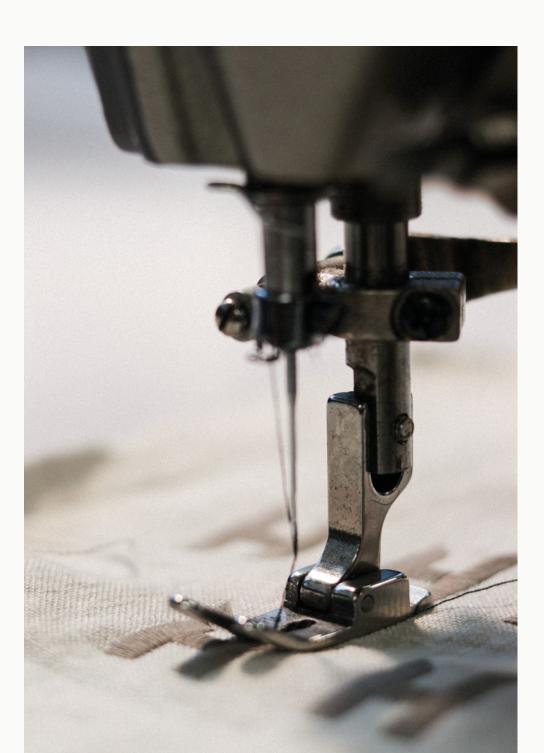

## High-quality fabrics

We use excellent materials to create performance workwear that's designed to last. Our clothing is made of lightweight, breathable, comfortable and durable stretch knit fabrics. #### Tencel

TENCEL® is a sustainable produced fibre made of Eucalyptus wood which is extracted from responsible managed forests with official FSC certification. The solvent used during the production of TENCEL® is recycled by almost 100%. TENCEL® received the 'European award for Environment' from the European Union for their unique production process.





Organic cotton is produced and certified to organic agricultural standards. The production sustains the health of soils, ecosystems and people by using natural processes rather than artificial inputs. Organic cotton farming does not allow the use of toxic chemicals, like pesticides, or genetically modified organisms.

#### BCI-Cotton

The Better Cotton Initiative exists to make global cotton production better for the people who produce it, better for the environment it grows in and better for the sector's future, by developing Better Cotton as a sustainable mainstream commodity. It is a holistic approach to sustainable cotton production which covers all three pillars of sustainability: environmental, social and economic.

### Recycled PET-Polyester



With this method Plastic bottles, made from PET, are recycled into Polyester. This is a source of plastic that would otherwise go to landfill and would create pollution. During the process it causes less air, water and soil contamination compared to the use of non-recycled polyester.
